Time: Arrival on Sunday, 5th of August, in the afternoon at Neheim-Hüsten, railway station, or at the airport of Paderborn-Lippstadt.

Departure on Saturday, 18th, in the morning. Transfer from and to the station and airport are organized by the Rotary Club of Arnsberg.

Cost and insurance: There is no fee for the participation in the camp. The participants have only to buy their tickets to get to Arnsberg and back home. They must have a health insurance which is valid for Germany. Rotary will provide an accident and third party liability insurance.

Applications: Use the rotary application form for short term exchange! The local rotary club has to recommend the applicant. The date of receipt determines admission. The participants are requested to send an email to the organizer of the camp to announce their visit.
